- Texte: Alle Texte müssen in Pfade umgewandelt werden.

GESTALTUNG & PLATZIERUNG

- Beschnitt: Hintergründe müssen 1,5 mm über die magentafarbene Stanzlinie bis zum Seitenrand reichen.
- Sicherheitsabstand: Kritische Texte und Logos mindestens 2 mm innerhalb der Stanzlinie platzieren.
- Stanzlinie: Hilfslinie für die endgültige Etikettenform; sie darf nicht mitgedruckt werden.
- Zwei Seiten: Vorab angeben. Seite-A und Seite-B getrennt liefern; bei identischen Seiten ausdrücklich vermerken.
